<u>Breakfast/Brunch</u>

<u>Bayberry Garden</u> - Open for brunch on weekends. Start with the grilled Caesar and end with the lemon poppy bread.

Nicks on Broadway - Great place for a boozy brunch.

<u>Julian's</u> - All day brunch.

<u>Amy's Place</u> and <u>Brickway On Wickenden</u> are a minute apart and both great choices.

<u>Lunch/Dinner</u>

<u>Tallulah's Taqueria</u> - Worth the wait in line for tacos, burritos, agua frescas and more.

Olneyville New York System Restaurant - Get a wiener "all the way" and some coffee milk a RI classic.

<u>Dune Brothers Seafood</u> - No frills seafood shack.

<u>Aleppo Sweets</u> -Great place for lunch and take some Syrian desserts to enjoy later.

<u>Los Andes</u> -Very popular Peruvian restaurant. Make sure to make a reservation.

<u>Kin Southern Table + Bar</u> - Southern comfort food.

<u>Plant City</u> - Collection of vegan restaurants.

<u>Tricycle Ice Cream</u> - Great dessert option.

Willing to drive an hour? Check out <u>The Nordic</u> a seafood buffet with lobster.



Drink

These are walking distance of each other so you can do a brewery trail. Check out <u>Beer on Earth</u>, <u>Moniker Brewery</u>, <u>Long Live Beerworks</u>, and <u>Trinity Brewhouse</u>.

The Industrious Spirit Company - Providence's first distillery.

<u>Verde vineyards</u> is 20 minutes outside of Providence but it's worth it. Also visit <u>Leyden Farm Vineyard & Winery</u>, 30 minutes away, they often have Groupon deals.

<u>Ceremony</u> - Find teas from China, Taiwan and Japan here. You can also book a tea ceremony/tasting in advance.

<u>Del's Lemonade</u> - A RI classic. A mix between an Italian ice and a lemonade slushy.



Play

Explore <u>Federal Hill</u> - It ranks as one of the best Little Italy neighborhoods in the US.

Between May and November check out <u>Waterfire</u>. A unique attraction where bonfires are lit all over the river. You can even <u>book a boat ride</u>.

<u>Gallery Night</u> - March through November on the 3rd Thursday of the month take a free trolley tour or walking tour to galleries, museums or creative spaces.

Museums - <u>RISD Museum</u>, <u>Museum of Natural History</u>, <u>Culinary Arts Museum</u>, <u>John Brown House Museum</u> and <u>Providence Children's Museum</u> for the kids.

<u>Thayer St</u> - Enjoy the vibe. Vintage shops, bookstores etc.

Take a <u>3 hour food tour</u>.

<u>Providence Flea</u> - vintage and artisan market.
